On September 2008, the Secretary of State approved the GOB GCC Accreditation—Recognition Platform and in 2009 the Department of Justice as a Registered Nonprofit charity trust, a Foundation. This authorizes the Charter to carryout activities that will benefit charities across jurisdiction wherein we carry Delegates—Technical Advisors worldwide. Funding provided through donations, fundraisers and grants we help, provide information and investigate byway of Regulatory Affair Practices and other activities.



Legal Acts in the State of California and the USA specifies that the GOB GCC Accreditation—Recognition Platform is to be operated and administered by a Board of Governance, which the Attorney General can designate an Board appointee. This entrustment as a non-profit charitable and chartered legal entity is authorized by US Act. The Department of Justice and the Government has the authority to amend the applicable Legal Act, by doing so, it furthers the purposes of the associative Acts as follows:

The NON-Profit Integrity Act, California USA

The Non-Profit Integrity Act of 2004, SB 1262, requires that “good governance”. This Act applies to non-profit organizations subject to the Act’s provisions charitable entities—corporations. The Act is effective 1 January 2005 and The GOB GCC Accreditation—Recognition Platform addresses each of their key legal obligations as follows.

- The GOB GCC Accreditation—Recognition Platform is a registered nonprofit charitable and chartered, a Foundation, organization operating in California.
- The GOB GCC Accreditation—Recognition Platform operates byway of a volunteer Board of Governance—Board of Directors entirely USA citizens. Thereof, there is no salary or distribution of funds received other than for the purpose to carryout the Charter.



- Fundraising and the GOB GCC Accreditation—Recognition Platform control of fundraising resides within the Board of Directors. Professional fundraisers (persons or organizations that fundraise for compensation) and fundraising counsel (persons or firms who provide fundraising advice for compensation) that we contract need be registered by the Department of Justice, Attorney General.

- The GOB GCC Accreditation—Recognition Platform finances are supervised by the Board of Governance—Board of Directors and an independent legally registered CPA Accounting Firm in Riverside California. The CPA will have a statement published as the Act determines.



- As determined by the Act, the GOB GCC Accreditation—Recognition Platform establishes an audit committee as that does not includes the Board of Directors CEO, Treasurer, employees or any person with a material financial interest in any entity doing business with us.

- As the Act determines, public availability of audited financials and make available to the Attorney general and the Public in the manners prescribed for making IRS Form 990 available to the Public in IRS ¶6104 (d).



When determining applicable, 2004 California Law 919 (SB 1262), amending Section 17510.5 of the Business and Professional Code, amending sections 12581, 12582, 12583, 12584, 12585, 12586, 12599 and 12599.1 of the Government Code, and adding Sections 12599.3, 12599.6 to the Government Code.
